

Understanding the Registry

Uploading Photographs from Desktop/Laptop Computers

Your photograph is imported directly from your Florida Driver's License or Florida Identification card. If the photograph from your Florida Driver's License or Florida Identification card does not automatically import, please contact your physician and confirm that your Social Security Number and Date of Birth have been entered correctly.

If you do not have a Florida Driver's License or Florida Identification Card, the information below shows you how to upload a full-face passport type photograph from your desktop or laptop computer to the Medical Marijuana Use Registry.

Step 1: Log into the Medical Marijuana Use Registry <https://mmuregistry.flhealth.gov/>.

Step 2: Navigate to the "Your Card" menu option at the top of the page to view your identification card application.



Step 3: Click "Supply a Photo" in the photograph section.



Step 4: Click on "Supply my own."

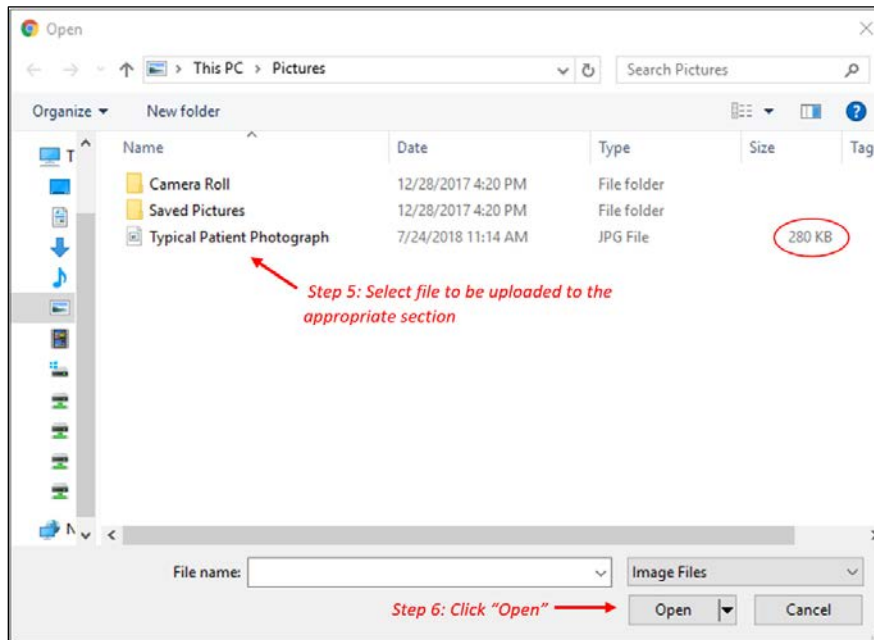


A window will open with the file paths on your laptop or desktop computer.

Step 5: Navigate to the location on your laptop or desktop computer that has the file you wish to upload and select it.

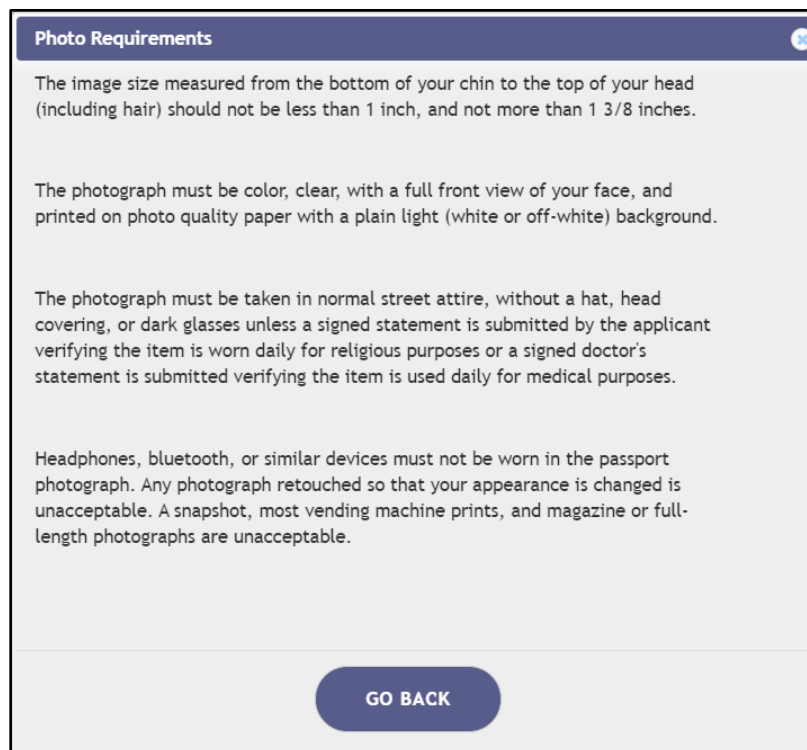
Note: the photograph must be 300 KB or smaller.

Step 6: Click “Open.”



You will be redirected to your online application, and your passport-type photo will be displayed.

Ensure that the photograph uploaded has met the mandated criteria for the photograph.
