

Understanding the Registry

Updating your Address for an Approved Card

You may update your address at any time, even after your application has been approved. There is a \$15 processing fee which includes the address change and a new Medical Marijuana Use Registry identification card. Updating your address will not affect your ability to obtain your Medical Marijuana orders. Updating your address will **not** change your expiration date.


Step 1: Log into the Medical Marijuana Use Registry <https://mmuregistry.flhealth.gov/>.

Step 2: Navigate to the "YOUR CARD" menu option at the top of the page to view your current, approved identification card application.



Step 3: Click "Update My Information."

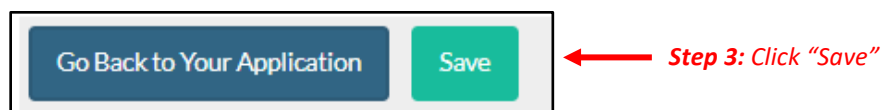

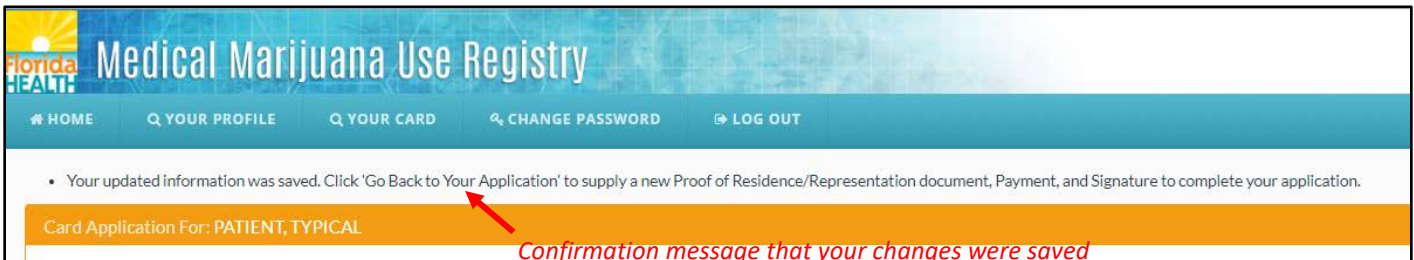
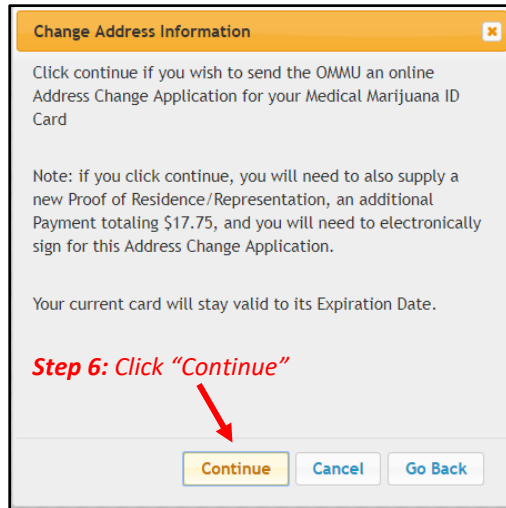
Step 4: Update your profile with your new information.

Step 5: Click "Save."



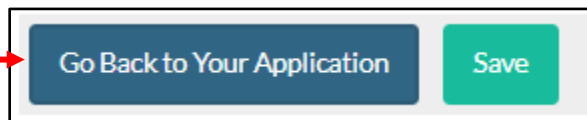

Step 6: A confirmation window will open, click “Continue.”



Step 7: Click “Go Back to Your Application.”

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Your photograph will be automatically transferred from your current approved application.

Step 8: Upload a copy of your new Florida Driver’s License or Florida Identification card under the Proof of Residence section. (Note, the address on your proof of residence must match the address on your application.) Click “Choose File.” Select the file you wish to upload and click “Open.” The document will appear below the “Choose File” button.

Step 9: Once you have submitted a copy of your proof of residence, you must electronically sign your application. Scroll to the bottom of the page and type in your first and last name in the appropriate boxes.

Step 10: Click “Submit My Card Application.”



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Step 11: Click the button “Click Here to Pay Online,” which will appear after you submit your card application.

Step 12: A new window will open containing the Bill2Pay interface, where you can supply your payment details. Payments by e-check and credit card are accepted. *A \$2.75 convenience fee applies to each online payment.*
