

## Understanding the Registry

### Self-Deactivating from your Qualified Physician

**Step 1:** Log into the Medical Marijuana Use Registry <https://mmuregistry.flhealth.gov/>.

\*If you do not remember your password, learn how to reset it by [clicking here](#).

**Step 2:** Navigate to the "Your Profile" menu option at the top of the page to view your information.



**Step 3:** Click on "Manage Profile Details."

\*If the "Current Physician" states "No Current Physician," you are not currently active with a qualified physician. Please contact your new qualified physician and have them activate you under their care.

**Step 4:** Click "Leave your Current Physician."

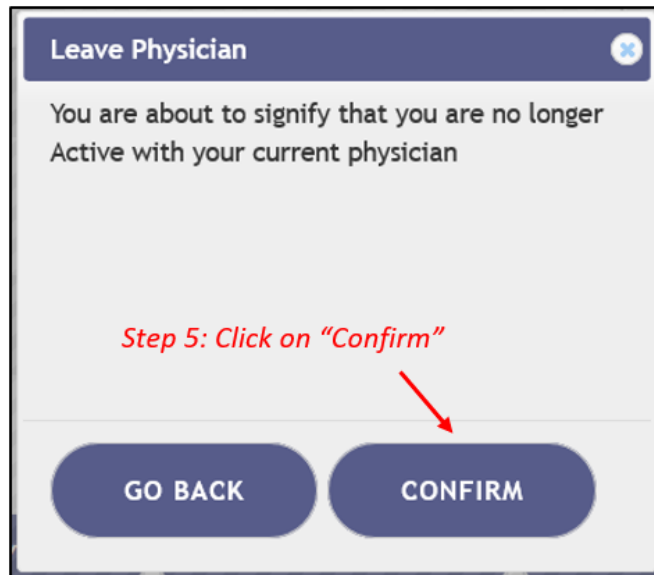
