



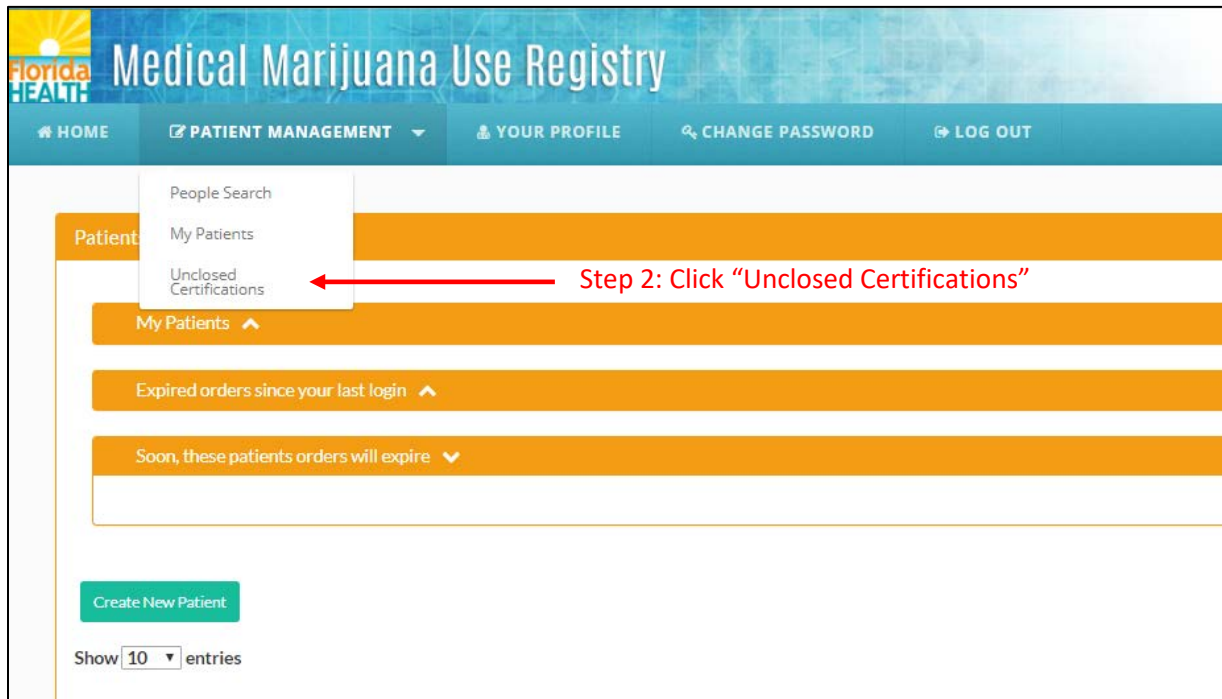
Understanding the Registry

Close a Certification

Step 1: Log into the Medical Marijuana Use Registry <https://mmuregistry.flhealth.gov/>.

Step 2: Navigate to the "Patient Management" tab at the top of the page and click "Unclosed Certifications."



Step 3: Locate the patient(s) with the certification(s) you need to close.
