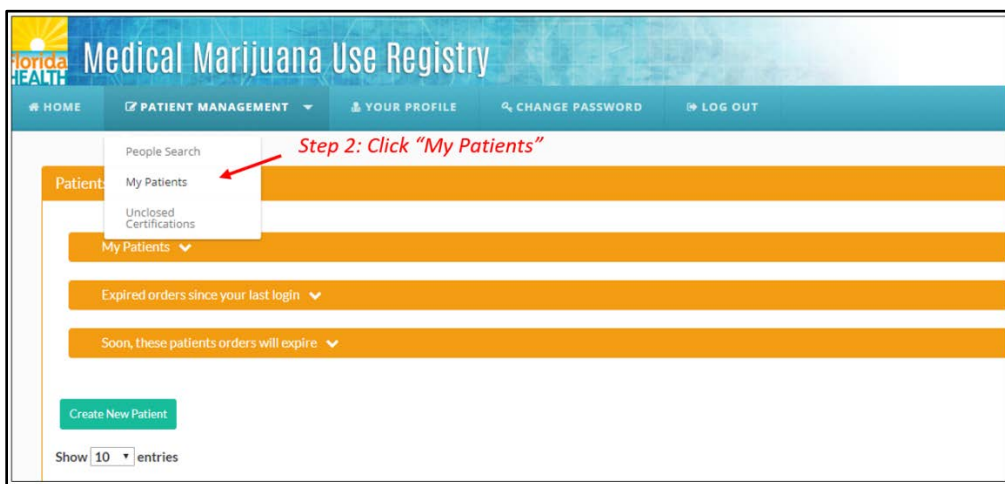
Deactivate a Patient

Qualified physicians deactivate the registration of a qualified patient and the patient's caregiver when the physician no longer recommends the medical use of marijuana for the patient and the treatment is discontinued.

Step 1: Log in to the Medical Marijuana Use Registry <https://mmuregistry.flhealth.gov/>.

Step 2: Navigate to the "PATIENT MANAGEMENT" menu option at the top of the page and click on "My Patients."



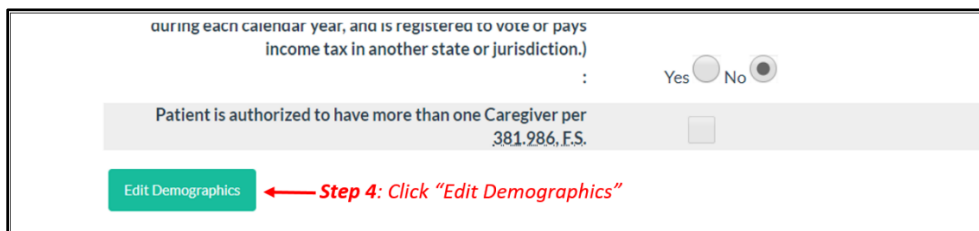
Step 3: Locate the patient you want to deactivate.

Note: Any orders for the patient remain open after you deactivate and can still be dispensed. Cancel any orders you wish to terminate prior to deactivating yourself from the patient.

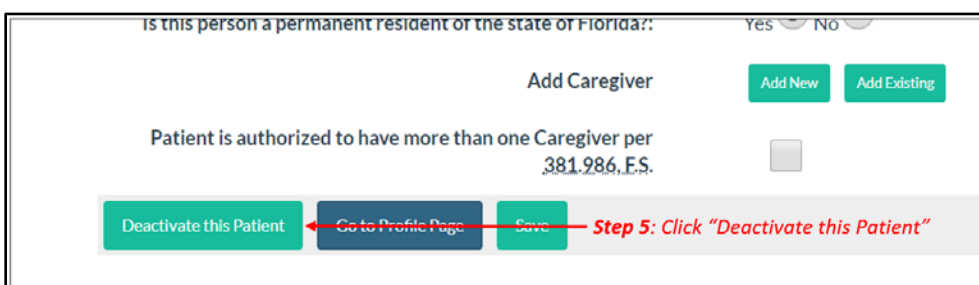

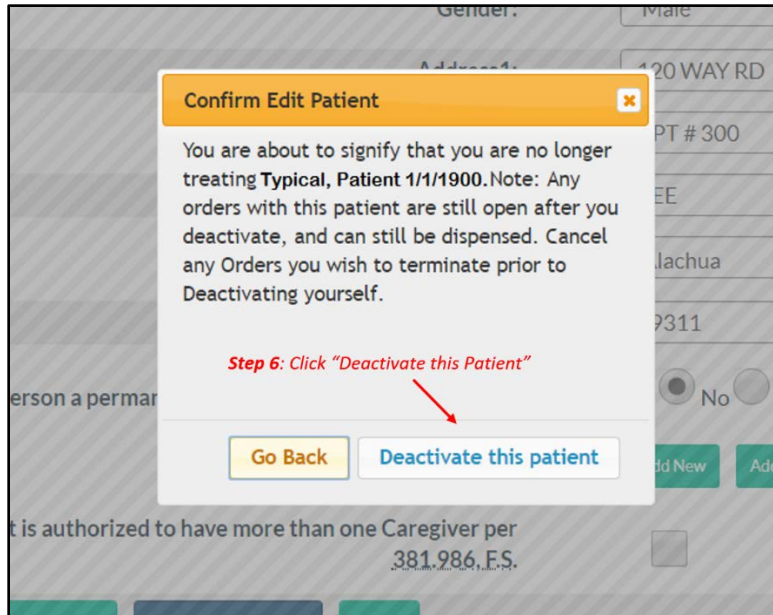
Step 4: Click "Edit Demographics."



Step 5: Click "Deactivate this Patient."



Step 6: Click “Deactivate this Patient.”



Verification that you are no longer being associated to the patient profile is visible on the upper left-hand corner of the patient’s profile.
