

Certifying Marijuana for Medical Use in a Form for Smoking

(In addition to the requirements of 381.986, F.S.)

Informed Consent

Each qualified patient, or the patient's parent or legal guardian if they are a minor, must be informed by their qualified ordering physician, and sign a written informed consent before being certified to receive medical marijuana in a form for smoking. That written informed consent must contain information regarding the risks specifically associated with smoking marijuana.

Patients under the age of 18 may not obtain a certification for marijuana for medical use by smoking unless the patient is diagnosed with a terminal condition. A board-certified pediatrician must also concur with the qualified ordering physician's determination if the patient is under 18 years of age.


Additional Documentation

Qualified physicians must submit additional documentation as now required by the amended statute when certifying a patient for medical marijuana in a form for smoking to their applicable Board.



Locate the patient's profile that you want to add the whole flower route of administration to. If the patient already has an Active certification and an Open order, please skip to step 5.

1. Create a new certification if needed. If the patient needs a new order, click the "Expand button" on the "Active" certification.



2. Click the "New Order" button.



3. Select the "Start Date" and "Duration Days" to set the time period the order will be open for. It is OK to set the duration to 70-days. Select Purchase Delivery Device, if you want the patient to be able to purchase a Delivery Device from an approved medical marijuana treatment center. Then click "Add Route."

4. Select the “Order is for” toggle to “Medical.”

Select the Route of Administration. We recommend “Inhalation.”

Set the “Amount (in mg) of THC per Dose” and the “# of Doses per Day.” If you only want the patient to have whole flower and not any Inhalation, make each of these boxes 1. Otherwise, set the Amount per Dose and Doses per Day that you want the patient to follow for the route as you would normally.

5. Add an "Order Note" for the order that includes the certification start date and the certification end date. This note will authorize the patient to purchase whole flower from a medical marijuana treatment center.




